## INTRODUCTION

The gospel of Luke records that Jesus sent seventy-two of his followers out into the world to minister to others. Jesus had poured into them, and now he expected them to pour into others. - 6. In what areas are you interested in serving on Sunday mornings? What interests you about those areas?
