INTRODUCTION

In this session, we will discuss four small, but very powerful words. These four words are found in different parts of the Bible, and come together to succinctly summarize the entire story of the Bible. Discover what these four words are and how they provide the language for understanding our relationship with God.

1. What are four words that describe this season for you?
2. Read Genesis 1:27. The first word is "of." We were created in the image *of* God. What does this tell you about our relationship with God from the beginning?
3. Read Exodus 33:18-23. The second word is "and." God *and* us. What are the ramifications of being separated from God? What was your life like apart from God?
4. Read Matthew 1:23. The third word is "with." God *with* us. How does Jesus represent God with us?
5. Read Colossians 1:26-27. The fourth word is "in." God *in* us. As a Christian, what are the ramifications of having Christ *in* you? How does this impact your life?
6. What might be different in your life if you were consciously aware that God is *in* you?
