INTRODUCTION

- 4. Why do we hesitate to give to others even though we have more than we need?
- 5. Is there a charity or particular group of people in need that is near and dear to your heart? If so, talk about why you feel a burden to help that charity or group.
- 6. What can you do this week to be rich toward others? What can this group do to support you?
