INTRODUCTION

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

2. Read Ephesians 3:10. How is the wisdom of God being made known through the building program of Buckhead Church?
3. How have you seen God work through the environments Buckhead Church creates? How have they influenced your life?
4. Sometimes people get suspicious about churches asking for money. What specifically are they concerned about? Do you think any of those concerns are prevalent at Buckhead Church?
5. There is an expectation that those who call Buckhead Church their home will participate both in providing open chairs and in inviting their unchurched friends to fill them. How can you make these two activities a priority in your life?

THINK ABOUT IT

Think about someone you know who has yet to connect with a local church. This person could be someone in your family, someone at work, or one of your neighbors. How can you be intentional about investing in them and eventually inviting them to Buckhead Church?
