INTRODUCTION

- 4. Where do you currently pray? How conducive is this place to having an intimate conversation with God?
- 5. Read Matthew 6:5-6. Why would God value a quiet, private place for prayer, rather than a busy, public place?
- 6. Where would be the best possible place for you to have regular, scheduled prayer?
- 7. How does God reward private prayer (6:6)?

- 8. Read Matthew 6:7-8. How does it make you feel to know that God values time and place over the words that we use?
- 9. If God knows what we need before we ask, why do we need to pray?
