- 4. In what areas of life—marriage, career, finances, faith—do you feel a tension between your dreams and your daily experiences? Explain.
- 5. What stops you from acting on the belief that God loves you and that his plan for your life is immeasurably more than you can imagine?
- 6. What would your dreams be if you truly believed that you didn't have to settle for the status quo?
